Parent Council (PC)


The Parent Council represents parents' views and supports the school in its educational aims. Our role is also to help all parents to get involved and to contribute to the life of the school.

Parent Staff Association (PSA)

The PSA organises social events and raises funds for the school. This year we have already organised a lunchtime café (raised £288), the Halloween disco (raised £1080) and still to come are more lunchtime cafes, the Winter Disco, Christmas Cafe and the Summer Fair.

Funds raised have funded the scooter pods in the top playground, smart boards, iPads, the coach to Lagganlia every year, and to support the Gaelic football team. We set up a new "Cultural fund" in 2015/16 which funded extra-curricular activities and trips out of school for all year groups, and this continues for 2016/17 with an increased amount for all year groups.

Our big fundraising project at the moment is to raise funds for the playground improvements project. We had an amazing 64 children running in the children's races in May 2016 at The Edinburgh marathon, having funded 2 children's places per class into the 2016 races, this raised over £4000! Lothian buses gold open top bus came to visit too! We've just heard that we were one of the top 5 schools with the most pupils entered, well done Broughton Primary School!

And with the summer fair raising £1876 profit we have gifted all of this to the school to buy new picnic benches and more loose parts equipment for the start of term.
