We are always delighted when parents volunteer to help out in our classes. If you are interested in helping out and could spare an hour or two each week please speak to us.


Lunch orders

P2 Newsletter Term 1

Interdisciplinary Learning

This term P2 will be learning through a variety of contexts, developing skills for learning, for life and for work. Each topic will be led by a particular area of the curriculum although there will be opportunities to foster links across our learning.



Discrete Subjects

Maths - we will continue following the SEAL programme. In addition, we will be learning about Shape/Pattern/Symmetry. The Broughton Counts focus for Primary 2 this term is:

Counting forwards and backwards in 1s, 2s and 10s.

Literacy - we will continue following the Literacy Rich P1 and P2 Programme.

French - we will begin to learn the French for greetings, numbers and weather.

RME – we will be learning about key morals that allow all of us to work together.

Music – we will be developing the children's awareness of beat and rhythm through following the National Youth Choir of Scotland (NYCoS) programme.

Technologies – we will be using IT to research information with the help of P.6 Buddies.

Planned Opportunities for Wider Development

As well as getting the chance to learn in lots of different ways, our pupils will also get the chance to learn through different experiences. They will record their weekly learning in their class Learning Log. The children enjoy reviewing their achievements. Each child will have an opportunity to:

- *contribute to assemblies by sharing class learning
