We are one of the smaller schools in Edinburgh but this does not stand in the way of high aspirations for the growing number of young people who choose to attend Drummond.



S4 pupils take seven National courses, and pupils in S5 and 6 can study five Highers as well as picking up other National courses to add to their portfolio of qualifications by the end of S6.

We continue to offer a large number of Advanced Highers. We teach the full range of subjects at National 5 and Higher levels, from Art & Design to Media Studies to Physics and everything in between. Learning and teaching is the key focus at Drummond and we provide iPads for all pupils to support this.
