What are the benefits?

Supports transition from Nursery – P1: focus on the needs of the child
'Learner at the centre'

Allows children to explore, problem-solve, negotiate, take risks and create meaning from their environments – developing skills for life and work

Motivating – involved in the planning of activities – children as partners in the learning process

Explore and learn at their own pace

Involves both child-led and teacher-supported activities

Open door policy


Communication
