Interdisciplinary Learning



This term our focus will be 'Our Community'. Within this we will be learning about forming positive relationships with others, discussing what makes a good friend and identifying important people in our lives. We will be discussing the changes in season from summer to Autumn and learning about the celebration of Christmas.



Learning Focus

Literacy



We will continue to explore a range of stories and genres through our daily story sessions and reading activities, paying attention to sharing our opinion on a story and giving reasons for our answers. We will be continuing to recognise our name and explore different types of mark making.

Numeracy and Maths



As part of our whole school programme, 'Broughton Counts', our numeracy focus will be counting forwards and backwards, number recognition, finding the number before/after and sequencing and ordering.

We will also be exploring simple 2D and 3D shapes in our environment, days of the week and creating seasonal patterns.

Health and Wellbeing



We will be settling back into Nursery routines, focusing on washing hands after the toilet and before eating as well as brushing our teeth. We will also have a weekly P.E slot in the gym where we will explore safe use of the space, moving at different speeds and changing direction through playground games. Mrs Ritchie will be starting a small music group.
