New Children and Families

All of our children that were transitioning to full time have now started their settling in plans or are settled full time. This has been a big change for all the children in the nursery and we appreciate your support in helping your child to transition into the full time routines. The nursery currently has no full time spaces available. We would also like to welcome the few families that are joining us part time between now and February. We look forward to getting to know you and your child.

Staffing

Mrs Welsh (Peripatetic Early Years Assistant) has joined the nursery team this term. Miss Bradley will also take on the role of Acting Depute Head Teacher from 20th January 2020.

Parent Consultations

Parent Consultations for all Ante-Pre School children will take place this term. This is an opportunity for you to meet one to one with one of the nursery staff to discuss your child's progress. Pre-School children will have their consultations in the summer term. More information regarding the consultations will be issued soon.

Primary 1 Registration

If your child is due to start Primary 1 in August 2020 and you have not yet registered at your catchment school, then you need to register them as soon as possible. Placements close in February.

Safety and Security

Children's safety is always a priority, so it is important to ensure that both the main door and gate to the garden are always properly closed. A gentle reminder that the latch at the top of the gate has to be closed over. Please do not use the door at the other end of the building as this is the door used by the school. The school carpark must not be used to pick up or drop off. Please use the path beside the carpark, the car park should not be used as a short cut.

The nursery team tidy the garden with the children during their nursery session. Can you please not stay to play on the tidied equipment when you leave at the end of the session. The garden closes at 3.30pm. You are more than welcome to play in the school playground. Can we also request that your child visits the toilet before leaving nursery as again these are cleaned in between sessions.
