

Bloom's Taxonomy Questions for Reading - First Level

COMPREHENSION

1. Who is your favourite character? Why do you like them? Use 3 adjectives to describe them.
2. Describe the front cover of the book. What did it tell you about the story?
3. Draw an illustration to explain what the story was about.
4. Is the story similar to another story you have read?

REMEMBERING

1. What happened at the beginning of the story?
2. Where did the story take place?
3. Who are the characters in the story?

ANALYSING

1. What was the funniest/saddest part of the story? Why did you choose it?
2. Which part of the story did you like? Why do you like that part?
3. Is there anything in the story that wouldn't happen in real life?
4. What could have happened to give the story a different ending?

APPLYING

1. Is there anyone you know who is like a character in the story?
2. If you were the main character in the story what would you have done?
3. What did you learn from reading the story?

CREATING

1. If you could give the story another name, what would it be?
2. Create a new front cover for the story.
3. Create a different ending for the story.
4. Can you write a new blurb for the book?
5. Create a new character for the story. How would this change what happens in the story?
6. Can you design something that would help the main character in the story?

EVALUATING

1. Which character would you like to be friends with and why?
2. Do you like the way the story ended? Why/why not?
3. Did you like this story? Why/why not? Would you recommend it?
4. Decide if a character in the story was good or bad. Why do you think this?
