Guide to Remote Learning

Whilst the school is closed, our learning will be provided through **Microsoft Teams**. This is in line with CEC policy. Every child from P1-P7 has been provided with login details.

If you have lost your child's login details please email your child's class teacher or the admin account.

At the moment we are also sharing class learning on the website however we would prefer children to access learning through Teams so they can converse with their teacher directly and be given feedback on their learning.

Each week all stages are given a Learning Grid. This is a grid of activities that can be done at home and include curricular areas like art, topic, technologies, science etc. These can be done over the course of the week.

Each day all stages are provided with at least one **Literacy Task** and one **Maths Task**. These will be in Word or PDF. Some of these will be supported with videos or PowerPoints. These are pre recorded by class teachers so can be viewed at any suitable time. Class Teachers will also occasionally be providing assessment tasks.

In addition to this there are support materials available within P2-P7 stage Teams from Mr Young, Ms Clark or Mr McHugh.

P3-7 Teams also have materials provided by Mrs Bertram.

Check in meetings – P3-7 Class teachers will be holding at least one weekly live check in meeting with children on Teams. This gives teachers the opportunity to talk to children about their learning and assist with any issues they might have been having during the week. Teachers are grouping children for this. This is an opportunity for children to talk to their teacher so wherever possible we would ask that children are given space to do this on their own. **It is for children and not for parents!** Check ins will be introduced at P1 and P2.

Assembly - We are planning to pre record a weekly school assembly. A link will be sent out through Teams. We would like to continue to share wider achievements and weekly Star Awards. Please let your child's class teacher know of any out of school achievements.

Expectations

We appreciate that home schooling has many challenges and is different for each of you depending on your circumstances. We do not wish to overwhelm you with daily tasks.

The minimum we would ask is that children complete the daily literacy and maths activities. When completed **primary 2 – 7 should be submitting this on Teams.**

Many of the daily tasks for primary 1 are provided in the pack.

Children should attend any scheduled live check in meetings with their teacher. If there is a reason children are not able to attend on the allocated day, they can let their teacher know and can will be allocated a different day.
