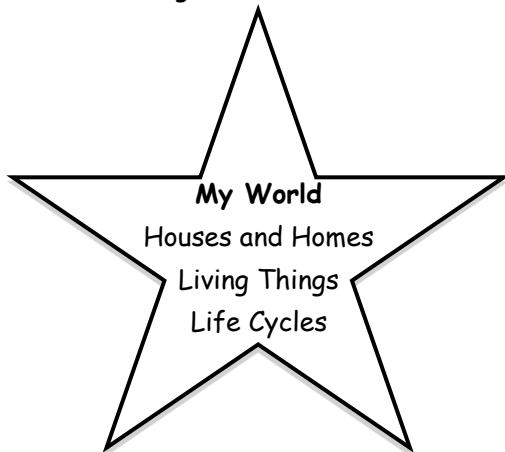

# P2 Newsletter

## Interdisciplinary Learning

This block P2 will be learning through a variety of contexts developing skills for learning, for life and for work. Each topic will be led by a particular area of the curriculum although there will be lots of opportunities to foster links across our learning.



## Discrete Subjects

- Literacy** - Children will look at magic e with soft c and soft g and heart words in Literacy Rich. In writing we are focusing on parts of speech and will do a block of Talk for Writing of a non-fiction text.
- Numeracy** - Children will continue to progress through the SEAL programme. We will be working with numbers up to 100 or 1000).
- Maths** - We will be focusing on 3D objects, Money, Directional Language and Chance and Uncertainty.
- H&WB** - As a school we will continue to teach the tools needed to develop resilience. This is done through the 'Building Resilience' Programme. This term we will be focusing on 'Make a Difference'.
- RSHP** - This term, we will cover- Friendships, Kindness and Empathy, and What To Do When Friends Fall Out.
- PE** - Sports Day Practice and Team Games
- RME** - How other religions express faith.
- Music** - Individual Singing and growing awareness of pitch and rhythm. YMI Visiting teacher block May-June
- French** - Weather, Describing myself (name, age, body).

## Planned Opportunities for Wider Development

If your child celebrates an achievement outside of school e.g. Swimming certificates, sporting trophies, Rainbows/Beavers awards, please share these with us. This can be shared in the whole school 'Big Book of Achievement' and then shared at our weekly assemblies.

Every day we will celebrate a Star of the Day and each week a Star Award is presented to a child or group of children by the depute head teacher.
