Interdisciplinary Learning

This term we are exploring 'Planet Earth', learning about different climate zones and living things around the world, recording the weather and exploring food chains.

Maths & Numeracy - Our topic Maths this term is Estimation and Rounding (rounding to the nearest 10); Fractions (halves and quarters), and Money (adding amounts of coins and notes and finding change). We will continue to follow the SEAL programme for Numeracy.

Literacy - This term is our second 'Talk 4 Writing' focus. We will be learning to write detailed character descriptions within our stories. We will also be learning to write letters. In Spelling we will continue to follow the Literacy Rich programme, learning our Block 8 Tricky Words and adding '-ed'.

P.E. - Our P.E days will continue to be Tuesdays (P3a) and Wednesdays (P3b) with Mrs Bertram and Thursdays for class P.E. We will be learning some fielding games.

H&WB -Our Building Resilience topic this term is 'Make a Difference'. In RSHP we will be looking at the units 'My Family/All Our Families are Different; Feelings and Safety and Similarity, Diversity and Respect (Parts 1 & 2)

R.M.E- we will be exploring key stories and values from different world religions.

Planned Opportunities for Wider Development
